







 Call a CCHC! A CCHC can further observe handwashing practices and offer one-on-one technical assistance on proper procedures as well as provide a training for all staff.

A child is injured on playground equipment.

 Call a CCHC! The CCHC can provide guidance on safe handling of blood and proper incident documentation. The CCHC can assess the playground and help determine what changes to make to prevent this from happening again.


#### **Current response to COVID**

From crisis management to prevention and management of communicable disease.

Continue to implement layered prevention strategies to reduce the risk of ALL communicable diseases

- Immunization for all vaccine preventable diseases
- Stay home (and get tested) when sick
- Daily Health Checks
- Ventilation

• Hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette / cleaning



## Managing COVID-19 in Child Care Facilities

Replaces the ChildCareStrongNC Public Health Toolkit • Follow CDC guidance: cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/community/schools-childcare

Except allows mask exemption upon return after infection or exposure
