New Business

Clearstream application currently on hold until all issues are resolved with some new system installations

Changes were made to the tire chip approvals in response to political concerns, specifically in increase in wire length by ¼-inch and local health departments will inspect the tire chips at the installation site. State involvement has been removed for inspection of the tire chips.

Float Box: Application for Approval (James Tyler)

- The committee was asked by the Department if the proposed product is something that should come through the I&E process. An alternative was discussed that included using the committee as a technical resource, but having the department handle the approval. The committee recommended that the department make the determination as to what type of application should be required for this product (Experimental, Controlled Demonstration, or Innovative). To the committee, it appeared that if the product is required to have I&E approval at all, that it seemed to best fit with an experimental process.

Old Business

Ring Industrial Group: Modifications to Innovative Approval (Ben Berteau and Jeffrey Karl)

- Addition of deep trench installation (36" to 60") provision with no reduction in linear footage as compared to conventional
- Addition of geotextile and 5 foot bundles for warranty systems
- Watched video from Duane Lyda on crushed piping in existing EZ Flow bundles under standard depth of cover (Section to follow up on)
- Committee voted to recommend approval with a change to clarify the trench configuration for the deep trench installation as 1203H and the addition of ASTM references for geotextiles as used in other approvals, with Cory Brantley and Jim McSwain abstaining from voting
