New Business

Infiltrator Systems, Inc: Modifications to Innovative, Controlled Demonstration, and Accepted Approvals (Dave Lentz and Tim Wood)

- Change of name for ADS approvals to Infiltrator Systems, Inc
- Addition of 1:1 sizing for LTARs greater than 1.0 gpd/sq ft for all innovative and accepted approvals
- Remove 35% warranty sizing for nitrification trench system reductions over 25%
- Modify EZflow innovative approval to match recent changes to EZflow accepted approval
- Suggestion was made to move the product models that are used on an infrequent basis to an appendix at the back of the document and keep the more frequently used models in the main document
- Modify the controlled demonstration approval to remove the Piedmont sites and place them in a separate approval
- Currently, the controlled demonstration approval requires all systems that will be monitored to be installed before the monitoring begins
- Committee suggested instead of pulling Piedmont sites out of controlled demonstration approval, make changes to the approval to allow for systems installed in a particular soils group to move separately to get innovative approval (move away from regions and to soil groups)
- Committee also stated that the company can begin monitoring the systems that have been installed for longer than one year and are ready to go
